



Disability Access

Melior Community Academy was designed and built to be DDA compliant in-line with current regulations. As a result there are no steps into or out of the building. All doorways, including fire exits, have level access to the paths to make this easier for wheelchairs, prams/buggies and people with restricted mobility. There are several disabled and restricted mobility toilet facilities on both ground and first floors.

From the main entrance gate there is a sloped tarmac footpath with bench seating intermittently along one side.



There is a raised (kerb height) pedestrian crossing from the main car-park to the footpath and access to the All Weather Pitch is flat and slightly sloping away from the footpath.



At the front of the building, close to the main entrance are several visitor and disabled parking bays. From here there is a sloped paved footpath with handrails on both sides. There is then a level paved walkway to the main entrance.



Inside the building we have a passenger lift from reception to the first floor. There are also wheelchair lifts to allow access to the stage for Dance/Drama on the ground floor and to P.E. on the first floor.

A selection of the classrooms are equipped with height adjustable tables. These facilities are also available in the food technology room, with a height adjustable sink and cooker.



Externally, both playing fields are easily accessible, either directly from the walkways or via the access ramp to the rear of the site, close to the sports hall. The hard surface sports areas also have level access.
